He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.

Image - Eiko'n the same as First Born - Protokas first in rank

Thrones - Royality
Dominions - Power and Lordship
Rulers (principalities) - Being first, The Leader
Authorities (powers) - free-will, choice, authority, government

if indeed you continue in the faith, stable and steadfast, not shifting from the hope of the gospel that you heard, which has been proclaimed in all creation under heaven, and of which I, Paul, became a minister.

2 Timothy 4:7 – I have fought the good fighter, I have finished the race I have kept the faith. Holding to a true understanding of who Christ is will not put in doubt their Salvation, but give them assurance as they continue in Hope
